The *Burlington Parks Foundation* is a private non-profit corporation classified as a charitable, scientific and educational organization under Section 501 (c) (3) and (4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. The official purpose of the *Foundation* is to:

- ☞ Acquire land for parks, athletic fields, playgrounds, public campgrounds, public gardens, museums, zoos and related facilities;
- ☞ Arrange for construction, maintenance and remodeling of improvements to such land and land in public ownership devoted to public park and recreational purposes;
- ☞ Support special programs, recreational activities, exhibits, and classes;
- ☞ Provide an educational forum to upgrade and enhance parks and recreation for the benefit of the entire community;
- ☞ Facilitate the acquisition and placement of artwork in publicly accessible places including arts in education, art in public places and providing a forum for community arts development and arts participation; and
- ☞ Raise funds and encourage private giving in support of the foregoing purposes.
